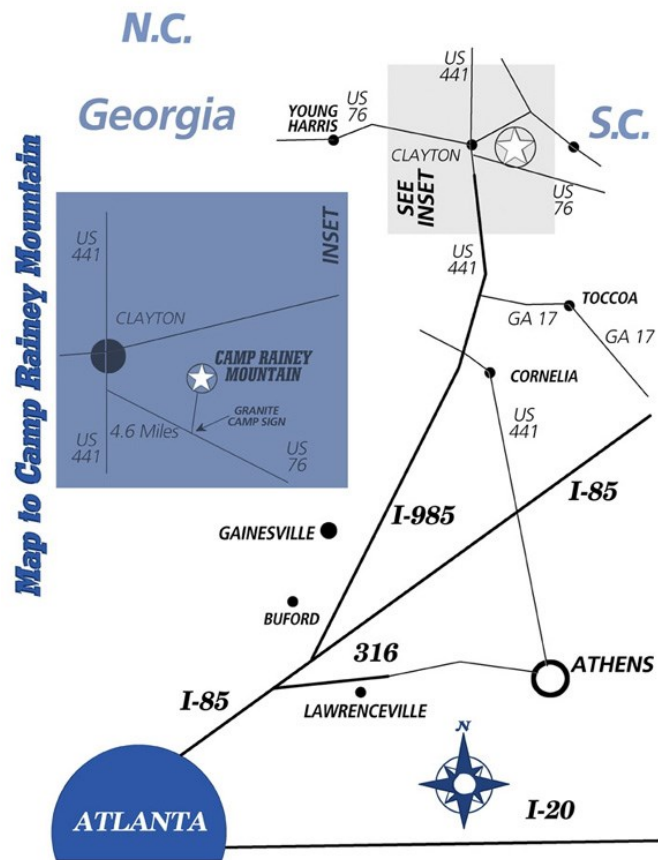

All vehicles must remain in the camp parking lot. Upon arrival (on Friday evening), vehicles will be allowed to drive into campsites to unload gear. Cars must then be returned to the camp parking lot. Only one vehicle will be allowed in a campsite at a time. If several families are camping together, this will decrease the time you must wait to unload.

Summer Camp Tents WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE

and you should come prepared to provide your own shelter. An Adirondack is a 3-sided wooden shelter with a roof and a floor. They are located in some of the campsites, but not all.

All meals are on your own. Campfire rings are located in each group campsite. Please **do not** make new Campfire Rings. Adults may use personal camp stoves for cooking - BSA policy on the use of fuels must be followed. Also, **FISHING FROM THE DOCKS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED!**
